Spina Bifida affects one out of every 1,000 newborns and is the most common permanently disabling birth defect in the United States.

Spina Bifida is caused by the failure of the developing spine to close properly during the first month of pregnancy, resulting in varying degrees of paralysis, loss of sensation in the lower limbs, bowel and bladder management difficulties, and learning disabilities.

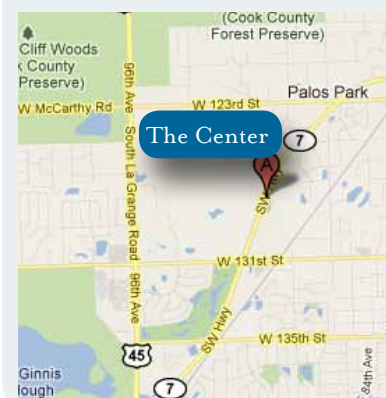
